The flu vaccine does not prevent COVID-19, but there are many benefits to the vaccine:


- 1. The flu vaccine **reduces** the risk of flu illness, hospitalizations, and death

In the U.S. during the 2019-2020 flu season the flu vaccine prevented an estimated:

7.5 million flu illnesses

More than the combined population of North Dakota, South Dakota, and Nebraska.





105, 000 flu hospitalizations

Enough people to fill more than 2,000 school buses.

6,300 flu deaths

The same as saving about 17 lives per day over the course of a year.
