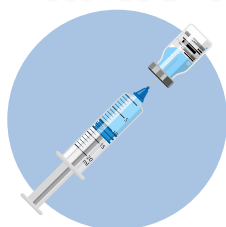




# Everything You Need to Know about COVID-19 Vaccines
